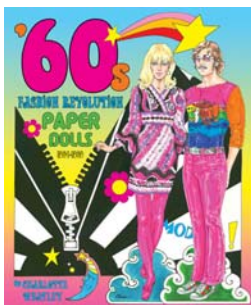
### 50th Celebration Day - 28th September DRESS UP IN 1960's STYLE



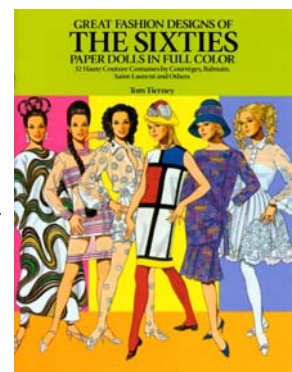
