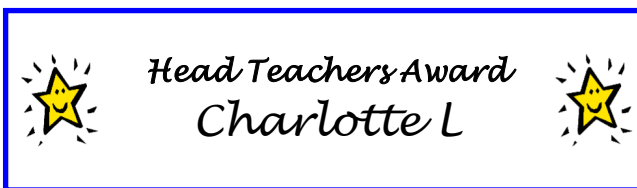

From 14th January 2019, we are delighted to commence our Magic Breakfast incentive. This has come through funding from the Department of Education which school have successfully applied for. To start our new initiative, we will be offering all children the chance to grab a bagel from our new Bagel Bar. This will be situated in the main entrance just outside the existing breakfast club entrance from 8:25am. This will include all children entering our existing Early Birds Club and Mini Pigs Club (these will be taken to the children in the hall once they are changed at 8:45am). All other children are then welcome to pop into the main entrance as they make their way into school for the day. A small basket will also be placed next to the school office for any children after 8:55am.
