Rules and Procedures for children: We are asking the children to follow some basic common sense rules at school during this ongoing situation to help keep everyone safe

- All children have been provided with a free water bottle, if children lose or damage it a replacement can be purchased for £1 at the school office
- Reminding children to play together without touching one another
- Cough into their elbow joint
- Dispose of used tissue paper in bins

We would ask parents to reinforce these points at home with their children.
