“All the better to see you with,” replied the wolf.



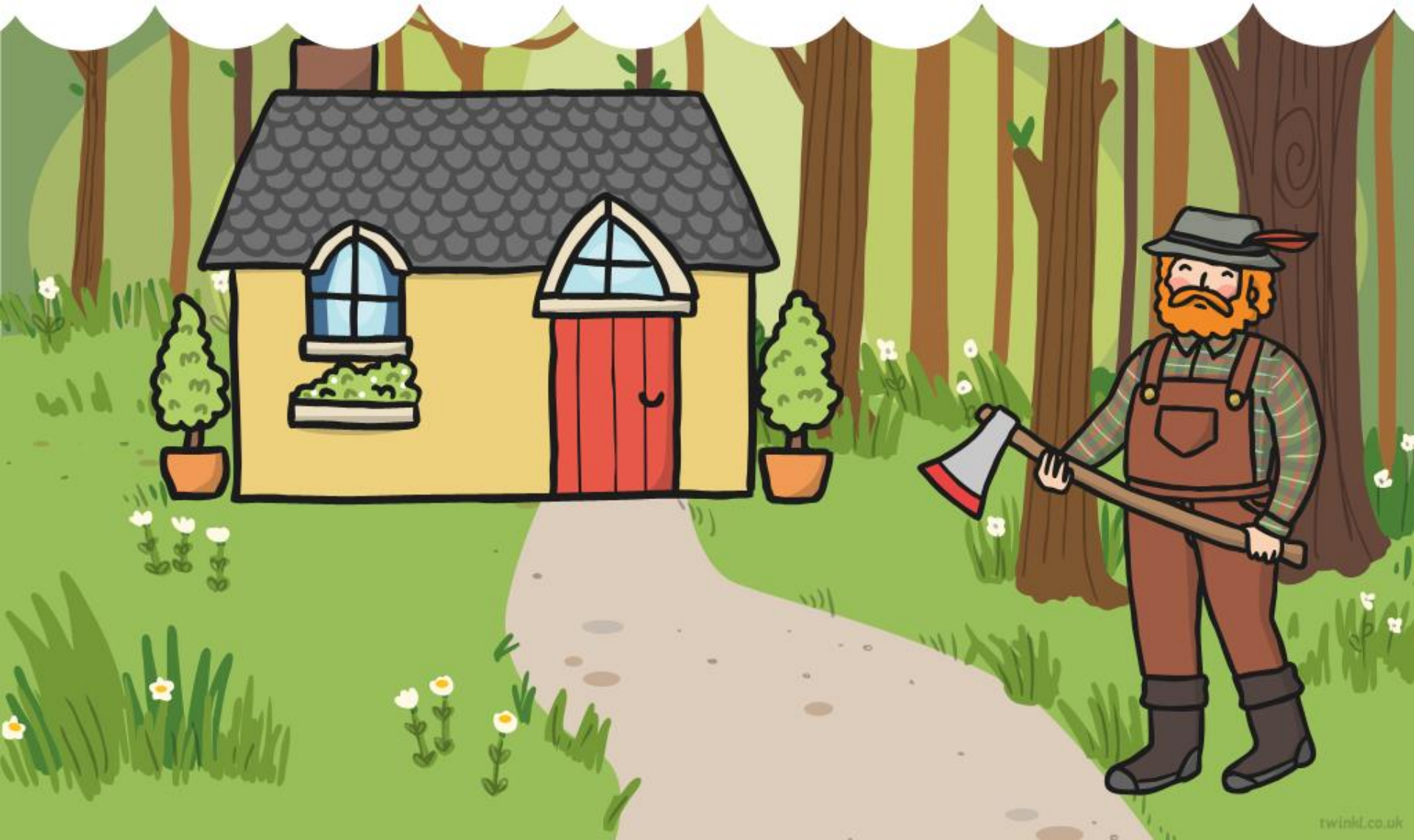
“Oh Granny, what big teeth you have,”

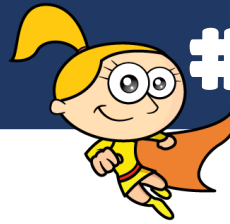


Look out for who has more!
