E.g. wrapping paper, tracing paper, greaseproof paper, newspaper, thin card, corrugated cardboard, sweet papers, A4 paper, drawing paper, shiny paper, tissue paper, blotting paper, crepe paper, wallpaper, paper decorations, cartons or boxes, birthday cards, playing cards, rice paper etc. Your task is to make a display of different types of paper. You should cut out a small section of different papers and stick them onto your worksheet and label them.

Extension - can you write a property beside some or all of the papers? E.g. tracing paper – see-through or translucent (allows some light through); blotting paper – absorbent etc.
