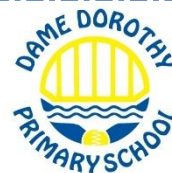

YEAR 5 WELCOME NORTHUMBRIA TRAFFIC POLICE

Year 5 recently enjoyed a fascinating and informative visit from the Northumbria Traffic Police motorbike team. The officers explained the vital role they play across the region, sharing insights into their training, the specialist skills required, and what it takes to become part of the team.

The children learned how officers identify uninsured or stolen vehicles and drivers without a license, as well as why police motorbikes are able to reach emergencies so quickly - and why those precious minutes can make such a difference.

Pupils asked thoughtful and enthusiastic questions and were particularly intrigued by the equipment carried on the bikes. Seeing the “stinger” up close was a definite highlight! The siren, radio and flashing lights certainly captured everyone’s attention - with plenty of hands over ears!
